Earth Day Coalition's new web-based Green Pages Searchable Database has just gone live. This is a reincarnation of the former "Guide to the Green Scene" printed resource directory which Earth Day Coalition has published since 1990 in conjunction with the annual EarthFest at Cleveland Metroparks Zoo. Included in the database are all non-profit and business exhibitors who either participate in EarthFest or join as affiliates for the purposes of a Green Pages listing. The database is searchable by issue area and multiple issues can be specified in a search query.
